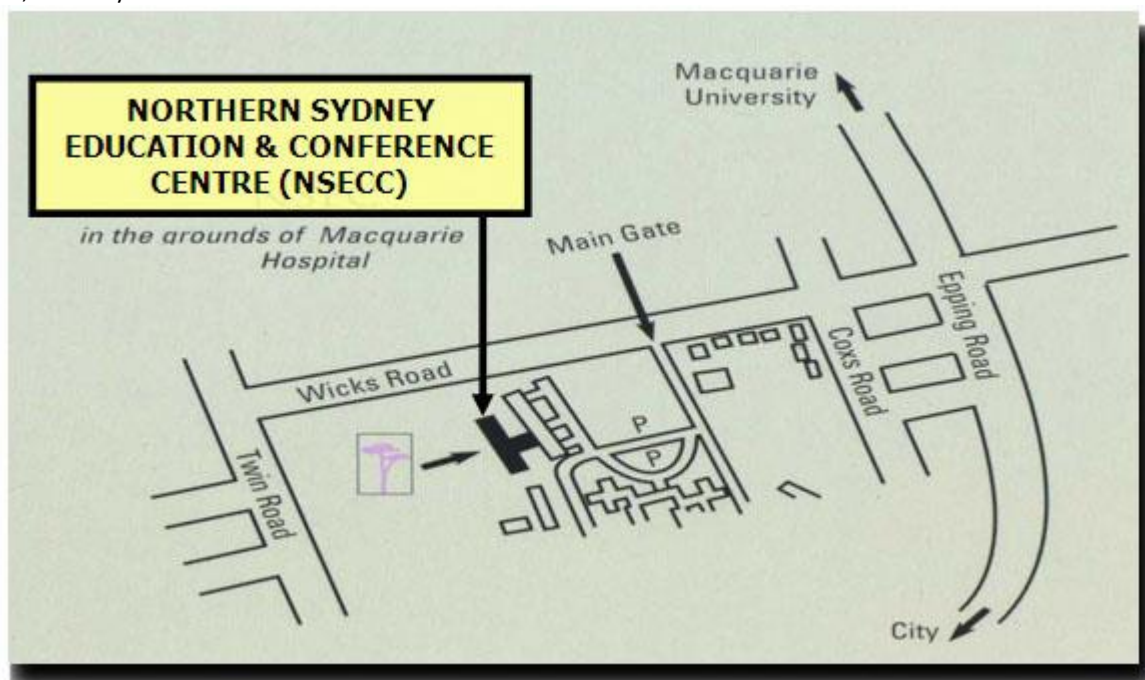

Access to Northern Sydney Education & Conference Centre is best gained via the Main Gate of the Macquarie Hospital Campus which is between 51 & 53 Wicks Road which is just up from the Cox's Rd / Wicks Rd intersection (about 80 metres) around the corner from the DRTA office.

After entering the Main Gate take first turn on the right into The Drive.
You can park either on the left or the right (this is indicated with the letter P on this map).

Continue on foot down The Drive approximately 50-60 metres until you see the sign to the Northern Sydney Education & Conference Centre (NSECC).

This sign will be on your right and is on the corner bend of The Drive. Walk down the driveway which is located on this corner bend. Northern Sydney Education & Conference Centre (NSECC) is located at the bottom of this driveway.

NB: Do not let the ACHSE signs confuse you as they are also located at the bottom of this drive.
